

CHECK IN POINTE DEVELOPMENT

Dancer Info Popup

Under current show routines, add the show order number for each dance.

Sub-users Locked Filters

For sub-users, add the option to set “locked filters”. They optionally can pre-define routine and dressing room filters and then the filters will be locked to those when that user goes to the Check In Screen and can only view the filtered dancers.

Add Dancers to Dressing Room

Change “Add dancers from Groups” to Routines on button and pop up.

Add Dancers to Show

Change “Add dancers from Groups” to Routines on button and pop up.

Messaging

Change Select Group to Select Routine

Change pricing for promo code

On the registration page and on the billing page (for demo users). If they enter a promo code, can we update the price to show the price with the discount applied?

Dancer Measurements - Dancer Details

On Dancer Details page, add a section for "Measurements"

Add fields for - Girth - Bust - Hips - Waist - Inseam

Input must be a number. It should format with one decimal point (for example 23.5)

Dancer Measurements - Routines

On View all Routines page, add a button for each routine labeled "Measurements".

When clicked, show list of dancers for that routine and measurements in a grid. The measurement fields should be editable with a save button at bottom or top of page.

Dancer Measurements Report

Add a report with dancer measurements. Can be printed to PDF or exported to Excel.

Can be filtered by All Studio Dancers or Specific Routine.

Costume Conflict Report

Under Show>Add Routines

Change "Sort Routines" button to say "Modify Show Order"

Add a drop down labeled "Costume change number of songs" next to "Sort Routines" with options for 1-10.

Add a button next to that labeled "Test Show Order".

This will pop up showing any dancers who have conflicting routines less than the number of routines in between.

For example: - User selects "3" from "costume change number of songs" - Dancer Jane Smith is in Routine 1 and Routine 3 of the show. This comes up as a conflict because there are less than 3 routines in between (3-1=2). - Dancer Jane Smith is in Routine 3 and Routine 12. This would not come up as a conflict, because there are more than 3 routines in between. (12-3=9)
